

WAAAGH! PACA 2019 SPORTSMANSHIP CHECKLIST

ETIQUETTE SCORING (16 POINTS POSSIBLE)

A great sportsman listens to the Tournament Organizer's instructions and follows those instructions. You will start with 15 Sportsmanship points. You may lose these prior to, or at the event itself, for failing to follow instructions. Some common Etiquette violations are listed below. This list is not exhaustive, as players are always finding new ways to annoy the Tournament Organizer.

- Submitting or changing an army list after the 12/31/18 deadline.
- Submitting an incorrect or incomplete army list.
- Submitting a list in an incorrect format.
- Failing to arrive to a game on time.
- Turning in an illegible or incomplete scoresheet.
- Losing a scoresheet.
- Failing to submit your scoresheet within 5 minutes of round end multiple times.
- Failing to finish your game multiple times.
- Vomiting anywhere but in a toilet or snowbank.
- Complaints from hotel staff.
- Destruction of hotel or player property.

Each player will get one freebie, one mistake that will not count against them. Use it wisely.

PARTICIPATION SCORING (4 POINTS POSSIBLE)

A great sportsman participates in all aspects of the tournament. This year, you will receive 1 Sportsmanship point for participating in each of the following.

- Donating one or more items worth a total of \$20 to the Charity Raffle
- Voting for your favorite Objective
- Voting for your favorite Model
- Voting for your favorite Army

COMMUNITY VOTING (5 POINTS POSSIBLE)

A great sportsman knows their rules and conducts themselves in a friendly manner. At the end of the tournament, each player will vote for their favorite opponent. You will receive 1 additional Sportsmanship point for each vote you receive.
